Dramatis Personae

main characters

Protagonist(s): hero(s) / heroine(s)

- someone who either suffers from actions of antagonist(s), or
- who senses some kind of lack, or
- who agrees to liquidate misfortune or lack of another person
- someone who is supplied with magical agent, or helper, and
- who makes use of it or is served by it
 - only sibling
 - youngest of three siblings
 - step-sibling
 - lazy / "fool"
 - special from birth
 - brother / sister
 - husband / wife

Antagonist(s): villain(s)

- someone whose actions cause protagonist(s) to suffer
 - sibling(s)
 - step-parent
 - step-sibling(s)
 - spouse
 - servant(s), clerk(s)
 - robber(s)
 - merchant(s)
 - evil tsar / tsarina / knyaz / knyagina
 - night spirit(s)
 - forest spirit(s)
 - water spirit(s)
 - witch
 - dragon
 - koshchei (the deathless)

Dispatcher:

- someone who sends protagonist(s) away in search or exile
 - tsar / tsarina
 - knyaz / knyagina
 - elder(s)
 - parent(s)
 - protector(s)
 - spouse
 - sibling(s)

Donor:

- someone encountered accidentally (in forest, on road), and
- who provides the [magical] agent that eventually liquidates misfortune or lack, but
- first tests protagonist(s) before providing agent
 - animal
 - magical animal
 - wise spouse
 - elderly person
 - wise counselor
 - forest spirit
 - witch
 - baba jaga

Helper(s): magical agent(s)

- someone who assists, rescues, solves and/or transfigures protagonist(s)
 - wise spouse
 - animal (bear, wolf, pike, falcon)
 - magical animal (firebird)
 - magical servants (sees-far, runs-fast, eats-all)

- magical object (replenishing sack / tablecolth, animated club)
- forest spirit
- water spirit
- prophetic

Person Sought-For(s):

- someone who exists as a goal and often recognizes and rewards protagonist(s) and / or punishes antagonist(s)
 - tsar / tsarina
 - knyaz / knyagina
 - parent(s)
 - sibling(s)
 - spouse

False Protagonist(s): false hero(s)

- antiprotagonist(s) or usurper(s)
- someone who claims to be the protagonist(s), often seeking and reacting like a real protagonist
 - older siblings
 - step-sibling
 - false "friend"
 - military companion

supporting characters

family members(s):

- elder(s)
- parent(s)
- protector(s)
- sibling(s)
- step-sibling(s)
- spouse

connector(s): advance the plot

- one character finds out something from another, and
- thereby links one function to the next advancing the plot
- information is usually announced, overheard or seen
- informers
- complainers, slanderers
- betrayers
 - beggars
 - servants
 - animals
 - magical objects
